Where to begin?

Subject Matter, Ideas, Source Images and Inspirations Develop your ideas:

- · Brainstorm in your journal
- Research art history, cultures, history, etc.
- Work with a concept (See Art Concept List)
- · Direction from your teacher

Evaluate YOUR Ideas:

- · Eliminate anything cliché, overdone or superficial
- First-hand observation of your subject matter is ALWAYS better than second-hand.

Your source imagery:

- will be developed from direct observation, art historical research and imagination
- will **NOT** be from internet searches and/published photographs

Journal

- 1-2 pages for each studio work
- Before, during and after each studio work
- Preparation, research, inspiration, experimentation, reflection
- Citation of ALL sources

Studio Work

- **Aesthetics:** Technical competence. The use of materials, techniques, processes. Experimentation.
- Concepts: Cultural, social and/or historical context. Communicate the stated intentions of the studio work.
- Media: SL: 2 Media Types, HL: 3 Media Types

Art Making Forms

2 D Forms: Drawing, painting, printmaking, etc.

3 D Forms: Sculpture, textiles, architecture, fashion, installation, etc. **Lens Based/Screen Based**: Photography, video, storyboards, digital
